- 1. Press button on bump closer to lock closer and open the door. This will release the pressure on the pin. Remove pin from closer door bracket. (Figure 1)
- 2. Remove one #6 x 1/2" screw from rain cap. Do not discard this screw, it is used in step 2. (Figure 2)

3. HANG HINGED STORM DOOR

Tools needed:

In this step, you will place the door in the opening and fasten it to the mounting surface.

Screwdriver

- 1. Set bottom of door into opening. Ensure orange bottom spacer is sitting on door sill (Figure 11).
- 2. Tip the top of the door into the opening while ensuring the bottom of the door frame rests on the orange spacer (Figure 11).

TIP: Place your foot against the bottom of the door frame while tipping the top of door frame assembly into opening.

- **3.** The door frame assembly is properly seated in the opening when the hinge rail is flush against the mounting surface and the hinge rail and bottom spacer (highlighted in yellow) are resting on the door sill. (Figure 12)
- Move door panel toward latch rail until orange clips installed in step 2 overlap the latch rail (Figure 12)

 Fasten the hinge rail to the mounting surface using six #8 x 1 screws (Figure 13).

4. SECURE HINGED STORM DOOR AND REMOVE INSTALLATION CLIPS

Tools needed:

 Fasten the hinge rail to the door jamb using eight #8 x 1 screws (Figure 14). Do not overtighten the screws.

TIP: Use a screw driver to loosen and tighten screws in Steps 3 and 4; a drill may strip the screw holes. If screws do strip, replace with $#10 \times 1/2$ " screws included in the closer kit

- 2. Remove spacer clips by loosening screws, and then slide clip up and pull away from door to remove clip. (Figure 15)
- 3. Re-tighten screws.

- Remove bottom spacer by pressing down on raised lip. (Figure 16)
- 5. Properly discard all orange clips.
- 6. Starting at the mitered corners, remove the clear protective tape from both the interior and exterior of the door frame, if applicable.



5. RE-ATTACH CLOSER TO DOOR AND RE-INSTALL SCREW COVERS

Tools needed:
