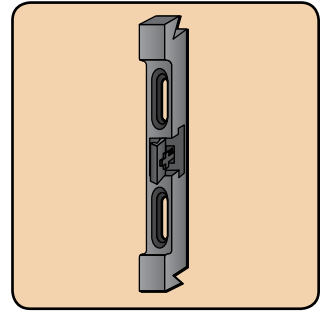

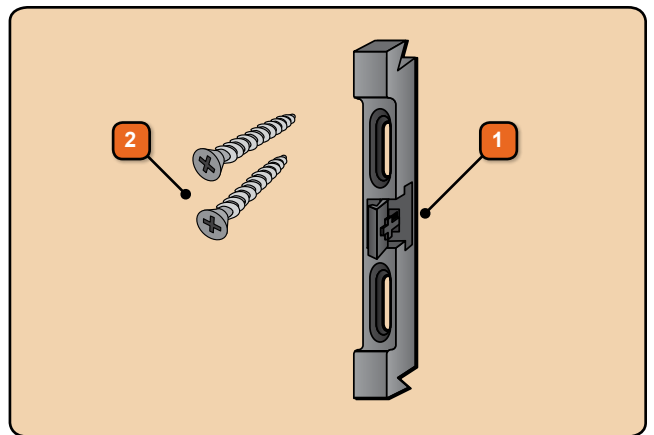

PARTS OVERVIEW

Your replacement part should contain the following parts.

- 1 Latch Striker
- 2 Latch Striker Screws

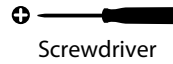

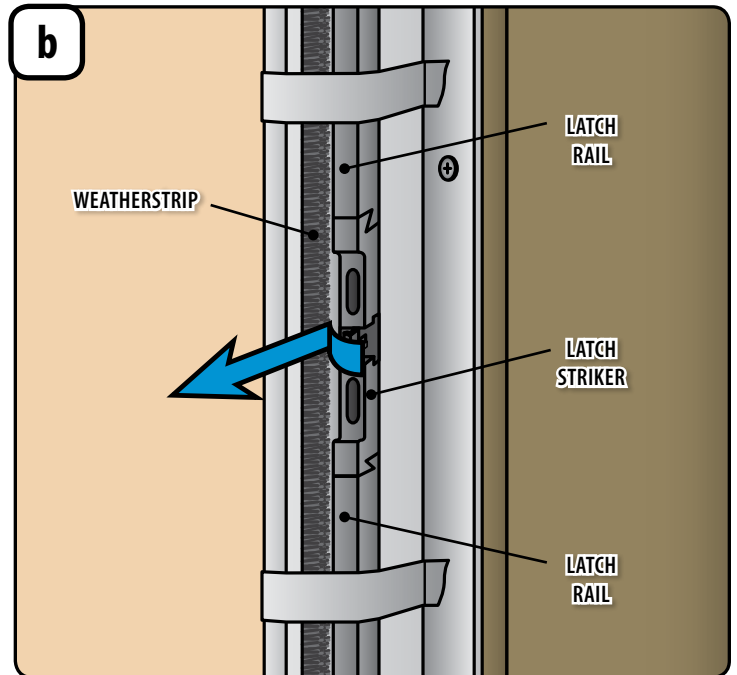
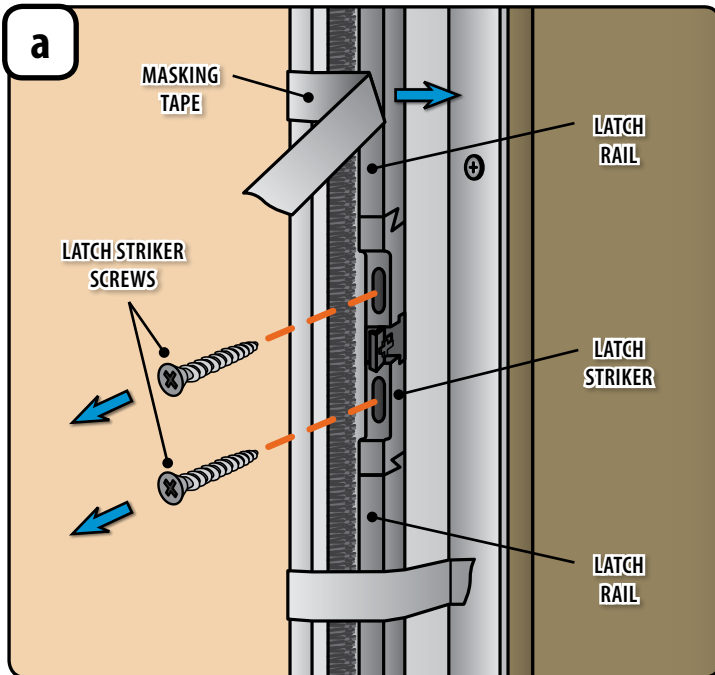
Tools Recommended:



Screwdriver



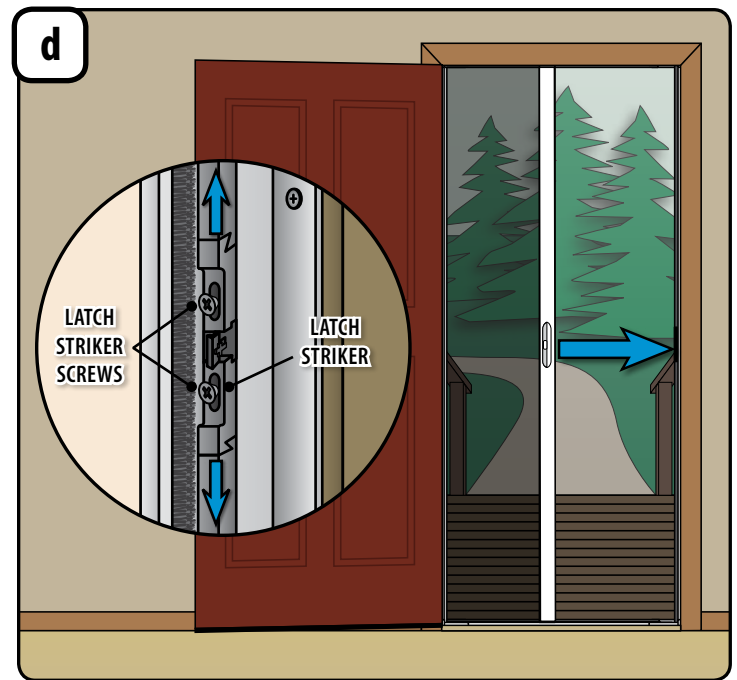
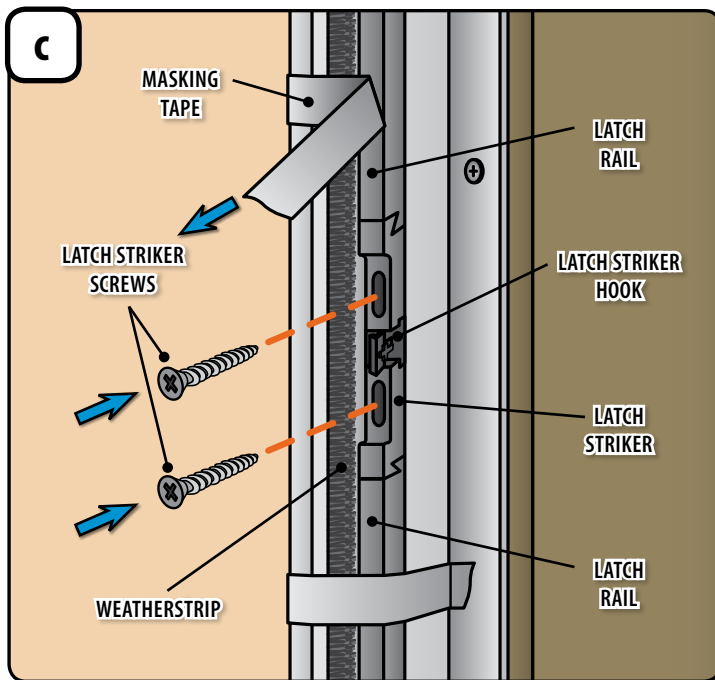
Masking Tape



a1 Apply Masking Tape over the top and bottom Latch Rails.

a2 With a Phillips screwdriver remove the two Latch Striker Screws from the Latch Striker and dispose of properly.

b Remove the Latch Striker by rotating toward Weatherstrip and out of the Latch Rails and dispose of properly.



c1 Rotate the Replacement Latch Striker into place, so it fits into the notches. Be sure to point the Latch Striker Hook toward the exterior Weatherstrip.

c2 Align the Latch Striker with the predrilled screw holes. With a Phillips screwdriver secure the Latch Striker into the Latch Rail with the screws provided.

c2 Remove the Masking Tape from the Latch Rails.

d1 Close the retractable insect screen to test for proper latching.

d2 If not latching properly, loosen screws and adjust Latch Striker up or down accordingly. Retighten Latch Striker Screws.

d3 Test and repeat adjustments until proper latching is achieved.
